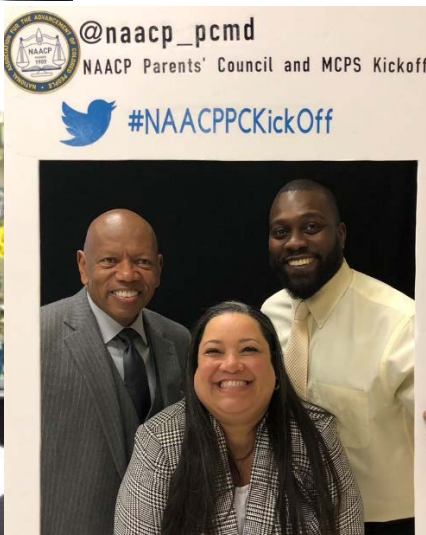
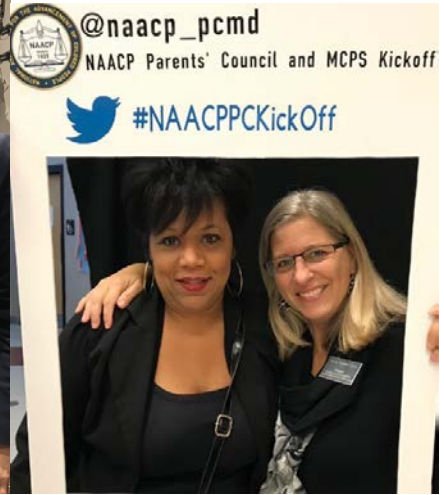
Education Committee Activities

3 Breakout Sessions were held:

Parents and Principal Equity Partnerships: Culture, Accountability and Curriculum -A discussion on effective approaches for Parents' Council, PTA and Principals to partner to create a culture of inclusion. Discussion focus topics include: 1) Partnering to implement the school Equity Accountability model; 2) Increasing diversity in the new Elementary and Middle school curriculum

Building Cross Cultural Relationships, Student Agency and Community in Schools- Discussion of MCPS Philosophy related to Restorative Justice - touching on brain research, multi-generational trauma, implicit bias, and MCPS data on disparities in discipline; Demonstration of Community Circles; Q&A on what Restorative Justice looks like at MCPS -

Your Voices Matter: Student Town Hall - This Town Hall includes a discussion about students' views on implicit biases in schools, needed changes to teaching practices, learning models, progressions, the school guidance system, and the normal, everyday interaction students of color routinely experience.
