- Complete the official application form. The application form may be reproduced but may not be altered and must be filled out completely.
- Submit an unofficial copy of school transcripts and two school references (original copies on school stationary), including one from a guidance counselor or an administrator.
- Submit the name of your current state Congressional member and/or Delegate

The essay must accompany the application. In addition, a three to four paragraph typed narrative essay about the applicant must be included.
